
The step-by-step process to becoming a certified NYSARR operator



## Top Five Reasons to Become Certified

- 1. Operational legitimacy
- 2. National recognition of meeting NARR Standard 3.0
- 3. Listed as a certified operator & can use NYSARR/NARR logos
- 4. Government funding opportunities
- 5. Higher sobriety percentages and better scientifically-proven outcomes based on the social model








#### **Certification Process**

- 1. <u>Application/Payment</u>: Create a Certemy profile, complete application and submit payment
- 2. Welcome/NARR Standard 3.0: After app and payment are received and approved, your welcome letter, NARR Standard 3.0 checklist and housing level form is available
- 3. <u>Submit Documents</u>: Required documentation for your level of housing is submitted via your profile and automatically saved as you complete each section
- **4. <u>Site Visit</u>**: After all documentation is received and approved by NYSARR staff, a site visit is scheduled
- **5. <u>Certification</u>**: Following the site visit your application may: A) be approved,
  - B) conditionally approved, or C) not approved. Upon approval, your profile contains your certificate(s) and acceptance letter





#### **Application/Payment**

On <u>nysarr.org</u> click the "Membership" tab then "Application Process"


Click "Apply On-Line Now" or contact NYSARR to request a paper application

Create a Certemy profile

Complete application

Pay fees online or by check/money order

Once approved, your welcome letter, NARR Standard 3.0 checklist and form(s) for your level of housing will be available on your profile



#### **Submit Documentation**

A form for your level of housing will be available on your profile

Click to view your welcome letter and NARR standard 3.0 checklist

The form may be completed at your leisure and automatically saves to your profile

Sections that are complete will turn green

Sections that are approved will be green with a check mark

Sections that are not approved will turn red and you will be able to submit a new document at that time

#### **Site Visit**

Confirmed date and time will be listed on your profile upon emailed agreement along with any notes

Site visit corrections will become available after your site visit has been completed and will note whether a revisit is necessary

If a revisit is required, the number of homes will be specified

- Section 2 of the NARR Standard 3.0 will be focused on during the site visit
- Site visits are completed once a year or at NYSARR's discretion
- There is a flexible schedule for your first visit, but site visits for renewal will be scheduled on or before the same date as the original
- Annual visits are scheduled within a month of your certification expiration date
- Approved: Home meets all the NARR Standard 3.0, no health or safety violations and no corrections are needed
- Conditionally Approved: Home met majority of NARR Standard 3.0 however evidence of making some corrections must be submitted within 30 days
- Not Approved: Residence fails to meet enough of the NARR Standard 3.0, 30 days are given to make corrections and a revisit is required

#### **Site Visit Proof of Corrections**

Files must be smaller than 30MB and have one of the following extensions: docx, gif, jpg, jpeg, pdf, png, rtf, txt, xls, xlsx, ppt, pptx

Upon review and approval of corrections, copies of certificates and acceptance letter will be available on your profile

Please note that the renewal process for the following year automatically appears on your profile but DOES NOT have to be completed until you approach your expiration date

Automatic emails are received as your renewal date approaches

### **Certification Renewal**

Once certification is approved, the renewal process automatically appears in your Certemy account

Please note that renewal DOES NOT need to be started until you approach your renewal date

Automatic emails are received about your renewal as your renewal date approaches

In the meantime, please keep your profile as up to date as possible with changes to vacancies, contact information, opening or closing any residences, etc.
